[Notes on document submission]

- ※ All application documents/forms must be completed in Korean or English
- ※ All application documents must be readable, undamaged, and may be disadvantaged if they are not readable
- ※ Documents in foreign languages (including English) must be accompanied by a notarized Korean translation
- ※ Do not accept information errors/mismatches, translation errors, spelling errors/mismatches, etc. on all submissions
- ※ The names of the person and his/her parents on all documents must include the English name on the passport and are not recognized in cases of spelling errors/mismatch, omissions/conclusion of the name, etc
- ※ All documents requiring original collation must be submitted at the same time as the original and verified (local special committee members can submit them to the International Cooperation Agency after completing and verifying the original)
- ※ Additional document submissions may be required as needed

Screening Method & Admission Criteria

1. Evaluation Criteria

- In order to secure fairness in entrance examinations, scores evaluated individually by one professor of the relevant undergraduate department and one or more other undergraduate professors are averaged and reflected

2. Admission Decision

- Criteria for Acceptance: Selection of high scorers in the order of meeting application qualifications and scoring a total of 60 points or more in the evaluation of academic plans and self-introduction letters
- Equalizer Processing Criteria: First place for the top score of the self-introduction letter and second place for the top score of the academic plan

- C. Full exemption: TOPIK level 4 or higher

Precaution of Applicants

1. All documents shall be submitted in the original form, and where a copy is submitted due to unavoidable circumstances, the document shall be received through the procedure for verification and verification of the original form (special member)
2. For smooth qualification screening, qualification screening documents (including English) in foreign languages shall be accompanied by notarized Korean translation
3. Any person who is found to have entered the submitted document is false or has passed by other fraudulent means shall be revoked, and the admission permission shall be revoked even if he/she is found to have entered the school by fraudulent means while attending school
4. In principle, all submitted documents and screening fees shall not be returned
5. The final successful applicants must be posted on the website of our university's International Exchange Education Center (<https://iiee.mokpo.ac.kr/iiee/index.do>) and must be registered within the designated registration period
6. Those who pass the foreign screening must maintain their foreign nationality until they enter the school (if they do not maintain their foreign nationality, they will be canceled)
7. The contact information, such as phone number, address, or e-mail, must be specified in the application form, and the disadvantage caused by the loss of contact is the applicant's own responsibility
8. Matters not specified in this guideline shall be handled in accordance with the standards separately set by our university
